

New Student Checklist for High School Students

1. APPLY TO THE COLLEGE:

- apply.vccs.edu
- Save your assigned Student ID # and MYLFCC username
- Dual enrolled students **do not** need to re-apply

2. MEET WITH YOUR HIGH SCHOOL CAREER COACH

- Discuss placement test requirements and determine if testing is needed

3. SIGN UP FOR NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

- lfcc.edu/nextsteps

4. LOGIN TO MYLFCC

- my.vccs.edu
- Follow the steps to set up your security questions and password
- After logging in select "Gmail" and set up your email account

5. APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

- fafsa.gov
- Regularly log into your student email to receive financial aid notices and updates
- Financial Aid Awards are not processed until all required information is submitted

6. ATTEND NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

- Bring your MYLFCC username and password
- Schedule your Academic Advising appointment

7. MEET WITH YOUR ACADEMIC ADVISOR AND REGISTER FOR COURSES
